



This is one of a pair of matching Coral Arbours. Both are made using an Asymmetric Gridshell structure, and constructed from locally sourced green Oak (the outer and inner shells), and locally sourced green Ash (the inner struts). The other Arbour is finished in black and white and is still being varnished in the workshop (available in July). The one shown here, and currently on display in the Hillier Gardens, Hampshire, is finished with a natural pigment which will mature in colour with years and weather.

The two operate together beautifully as a pair of bench-sculptures, reflecting one another in design and style and size but different in colour which creates an external asymmetry to mirror the internal asymmetry contained within each structure. Visitors will be simultaneously intrigued and enchanted.

One Coral Arbour will create an amazing focal point in a variety of settings: a unique 'nest' in the corner of a garden with roses growing over it, on a small concrete roof garden of a modern hotel, or in a public space.

The Coral Arbours are priced individually at £8,000. If both are bought together then a discount applies.
